

The meeting of the Board of Education was held at the Alternative Energy Building on March 13, 2017 at 7:30 P.M. Vice President Blocher called the meeting to order. Members present were Blocher, Brockmann, Hoffman, Luebbert, and Reimers. Case was absent. Also present was Superintendent McAllister along with administrators Mitzel, Konkoleski, and Moran.

Vice President Blocher called for an approval for the agenda. Reimers made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Hoffman seconded that motion. Ayes: Blocher, Brockmann, Hoffman, Luebbert and Reimers. Nays: None. Absent: Case. Motion carried.

Luebbert made a motion to accept the consent agenda as presented and to excuse the absence of Case. Brockmann seconded that motion. Ayes: Brockmann, Hoffman, Luebbert, Reimers, and Blocher. Nays: None. Absent: Case. Motion carried.

Administrative reports were presented. Some highlights from the reports are: Staff evaluations are getting completed. Parent nights continue at the Elementary school. Jump Rope for Heart is currently going on. Field trips are starting. Dr. Seuss Day was held and with that Wildlife encounters program came for 2 evening sessions. There was a good turnout for both sessions. Miss Nebraska came and spoke to the middle and high school students about cyber safety and bullying. Students are being registered for classes for the 2017-18 school year. Spring sports have started. Currently in the high school there are 60 out for track, 11 boys out for golf including 2 from Scribner- Snyder and good numbers are out for baseball. State speech will be March 23rd, Quiz bowl will be March 27th. State FCCLA, FFA, FBLA all have state conventions coming up. Congratulations to Mitchell Lierman and Diego Rivera on making it to State speech for their duet.

Superintendent McAllister presented his report. He informed the board of the school calendar changes, there will be school 03/31 instead of an in-service, school will go until May 19th instead of the 17th due to the amount of snow days. There are some current legislative bills that the schools are watching. Will have more information from the city this week regarding the water issue and the extension of Kaup Road. He talked with the board on limiting the class sizes for new incoming option students starting in the 2017-18 school year.

Discussion items were about the need for some moving of rooms to accommodate some needs for the school. The administration will look at this once registration is done with the high school.
