

West Point Public Schools Protective Mask/Face Covering Agreement

In order to contain the spread of COVID-19, at the recommendation of the Elkhorn Logan Valley Public Health Department in conjunction with guidelines published by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention, the West Point Public Schools district reopening plan includes several instances in which the use of protective masks or face coverings may be required by all persons while on district property or in district-owned vehicles throughout the 2020-2021 school year. These instances may include situations where social distancing is not possible, in classrooms shared with multiple groups/grade levels, in classrooms shared with staff members or students who are immuno-compromised, or school-wide due to the assessed COVID-19 risk level of our community. Additionally, West Point Public Schools reserves the right to require protective masks or face coverings at any time it feels it is in the best interest of protecting the health of our students, staff, or community. If your child is unable to wear a protective mask or face covering due to a diagnosed medical condition, please have your primary care physician fill out the section below, sign it, and include your signature as the parent/guardian of the student, as well.

By signing this form, both the physician and the parent/guardian are verifying that the diagnosed medical condition of the student renders them unable to wear a protective mask or face covering, and both understand the inherent risk posed to the not only the student, but also those around them by not wearing a protective mask or face covering when West Point Public Schools deems it necessary.
